


Go From Word Document to eBook Published on Amazon in 10 Easy Steps

1. Write your book in a word document. The order I recommend is Title, Subtitle, Name, Introduction (Why should your audience read your book), Bio (why should your audience care that you wrote this book, how do they benefit from you writing this book and what should they do to work with you a in deeper way?), Table of Contents, Body of the Book, About the Author (more about your other books, programs, ways to work with you, call to action), Other resources.

Make a table of contents (In the references section of the Word document)

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4. Make the **Weblinks live** (also from the Insert a Hyperlink tab)

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9. Next set up your Author's Page on Amazon at Author's Central (also free of charge)


As an example here is my author's page.
